CALCULATING HANDICAPS

- 1. We are using the Golf Software program Custom Handicapping Mode because the USGAcalculation uses the lowest 8 out of 20 scores to calculate a handicap index.
- 2. With the ABQSGA only accumulating a maximum of 10 scores per year, it takes at least 1 year to meet the full requirements if all tournaments are played.
- 3. By using the Custom handicapping mode, no index is produced, only a handicap. This is why players need to play from their preferred tee box throughout the whole year. It is not possible to generate a handicap for different tee boxes without a handicap index. If players use a different tee box they will not have a valid handicap for the tournament.
- 4. Using the custom handicapping mode and using 10 scores (which should cover a year), the system calculates handicaps based on the lowest 4 out of 10 scores following the parameters listed below.
- A) Handicap percentage 96%
- B Number of scores handicap is based on Lowest 4 out of 10
- C) Two scores are needed before a handicap can be calculated using the handicap program.
- D) For new members the handicap chairman will assign a handicap based on an existing handicap index or the latest 10 scores if available.

Players without either will be eligible to win after 2 rounds.

E) Below is the schedule for the number of scores recorded and scores discarded:

remain on the score list if you do not have the total of 10 scores yet.

- 6. Upon re-enrollment, if you have not recorded 10 scores for the year, your scores will be carried over to the new year to a maximum of 10 scores.
